Revision Tips!

Strategy One:



Have your timetable in clear view to keep you on track.

Clear the area - have a desk you can go to to revise.



Use a timer, alarm or a clock to keep track.



Stick post-it notes around your room to help recall key facts.

Strategy Two:

Use both sides: one side for the title and the other for the facts.



Write 5 to 10 points per card - record only the key info on there!



Use COLOUR, images, diagrams doodles, and photos.



Write facts in CAPITAL LETTERS as it takes longer and helps your brain to process the info.

Strategy Three:

Active Recording:

- Record the question
- Leave a space
- Record the answer

Flexibility to record longer pieces or shorter sound bites.



On-the-Go! Revise anytime, anywhere!



Digital Recording

Repeat hearing the information.



Practice Questions - answer in your head, you don't always have to write!

Use the active recording strategies to help with retrieval of facts.

Strategy Four:

Bullet point key information to remember.

Create a mind map for each topic covered within the subject.



Record all the key definitions.



Add images and diagrams.



Connect ideas with colour



Stick on a wall so you can see each time you walk past.

Hide parts with post-its to recall facts.

Practise using past papers.



Use exam board mark schemes.
